Based on the information that you submitted regarding your home state DBE certification, we are pleased to notify you that your firm, Aquilla & Neptun, LLC, has been certified as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise by the Maine Department of Transportation and will be listed in our Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Directory. Your annual renewal date is November 23, 2016.

Your certification will be renewed based on your firm's ability to *provide proof of your homestate Department of Transportation or its designee's certification each year*. The only acceptable evidence shall be limited to a letter/certificate from the home state **Department of Transportation** which specifically states the firm's name, firm's owner, a brief description of the firm's scope of work or professional service, if a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise, Woman Business Enterprise, Minority Business Enterprise or other Socially and Economically Disadvantaged Enterprise (includes US SBA certification), and the date through which the certification is authorized.

Failure to comply with these requirements within *30 days of your homestate renewal date* will result in the deletion of your firm's name from the Maine Department of Transportation's Directory of DBEs. As a minority owned firm, your participation in contracts may be counted toward the Department's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Commitments.
